RE: 2022 Legislative Education Action Program (LEAP) Conference Information

Dear Colleagues:

I have scheduled the 52nd Annual LEAP Conference to be held at the historic Mayflower Hotel in Washington, D.C. Please plan to arrive on Sunday, April 24 and depart Wednesday, April 27. The conference's general session will be Monday, April 25 and Tuesday, April 26. The congressional reception for all delegates, family and guests will be held Tuesday evening, April 26. Wednesday, April 27 may be used as an additional lobbying day. Only union members who are registered to vote may participate as delegates. There will be approximately one hundred and seventy-five delegates from the industrial and construction sectors in attendance.

BOOK YOUR LEAP HOTEL NOW!

- **The Mayflower reservation cut-off is *Friday, April 1 at 6pm ET* but we may not have any rooms available if you do not reserve early**
In the past few years we have run out of rooms in our discounted block. We did find an overflow hotel, but usually at a higher rate. It is easier to request additional discounted rooms at The Mayflower, before it completely sells out, than it is to find a last-minute hotel in D.C.
- **Reserve your Mayflower hotel rooms now WITHOUT penalty**
The Mayflower *does not* charge your credit card until the day you check in. **You can cancel your reservation up to 72 hours in advance of your arrival date without penalty.** The Mayflower is a Marriott property. The discounted LEAP rate is \$347 single/double; plus 14.95% tax.
- **If you need to reserve a room before or after the usual conference dates of Sunday, April 24 to Wednesday, April 27, book as soon as possible**

TENTATIVE ISSUES FOR LEAP 2022

Specific legislative issues for the 2022 LEAP conference will be announced after Congress returns in January and sets forth their legislative agenda for the new year. At this time, the House and Senate have yet to agree on a final “budget reconciliation” package which may include certain policies of interest to us, including energy tax provisions for CCS and Hydrogen and labor provisions to enhance unionization, increase anti-union activity penalties on employers, etc. (Unfortunately, due to Senate budget rules, the entire PRO Act cannot be included, only certain pieces.)

Once Congress does pass the reconciliation package and we see what provisions made the cut or not, we will have a better idea of where we need to focus our lobbying efforts in April.

We always welcome other suggestions for our annual lobby visits, so please feel free to pass your ideas on to us. Please keep in mind that we need to avoid specific, local issues for our main topics, but delegates should certainly make those a priority when you visit your own Members of Congress and make the best use of your time with them.

We will update the LEAP website www.LEAPinDC.org accordingly to keep you informed in a timely manner.

We have a lot to discuss at LEAP this year and we look forward to a very productive conference.
